

RULES OF THE RANCH

For the SAFETY and enjoyment of the horses here at the Ranch, please be aware of the following rules:

Visitors must stay within the white fenced area for safety. This rule applies to parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, siblings, and friends, even if they have knowledge of horses. HORSES BITE!!! Do not touch or feed the horses unless told to do so by an Instructor.

- Do not run, scream, yell or throw objects within the Ranch grounds.
- Children under 6 years of age must be accompanied by Ranch personnel outside the white fencing.
- Please leave all pets at home.
- Please discard all trash in the can provided within the white fenced area.

BOARDER'S RULES

Ranch hours are from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm Monday through Friday, 8:00 am to 4:00 pm on Saturday and 10:00 am to 2:00 pm on Sunday.

A responsible person must be present while you ride. You may not ride alone.

Please lunge your horse in the brown wooden round corral only. The two other round corrals are used for turnout. The arenas are for riding only. Do not leave your horse unattended.

Please respect students and Instructors during lesson times. Please tack up quietly away from students, if possible (do not use the cross-ties when students are present). Always be aware of students and Instructors when riding in the arenas, taking care not to interfere. If an instructor asks you to leave, please do so. Remember your arena manners, ride left shoulder to left shoulder.

Please keep all work areas clean. Pick up your horse's manure and deposit in the small cans provided and clean up any hair or other debris. Leave wash rack area clean and put away hose. Please make sure to remove any personal items, including brushes, buckets, halters, etc. from work areas.

Tack rooms are provided for boarders. Ranch Owners are not responsible for loss or damage to any items stored within. Any changes or additions to the tack rooms must be discussed with Jim.

Do not turn out or supplement any horse that is not your own without Jim and Carol's prior knowledge.

Be safe, wear a helmet. Ask questions. Have fun!
